John Fraser is a graduate of the University of Edinburgh and pursued postgraduate studies at the Royal College of Music. He retired from his position as Chief Producer EMI Classics in 2007 after thirty years of producing highly acclaimed recordings with violinists Yehudi Menuhin, Itzhak Perlman, Maxim Vengerov; singers Kiri Te Kanawa, Janet Baker, Lucia Popp, Placido Domingo, Ian Bostridge; pianists Leif Ove Andsnes, Stephen Kovacevich, Ingrid Fliter; conductors Mariss Jansons, Neville Marriner, Daniel Barenboim, Bernard Haitink, Wolfgang Sawallisch; and the celebrated Belcea Quartet. Since leaving EMI, John has pursued a very active freelance career as a recording producer continuing to work with Andsnes, Fliter, Vengerov, Bostridge, Belcea Quartet and, since 2011, conductor Riccardo Chailly.
